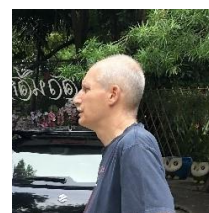

### **Info about the 4 who moved to hashing in the sky this year!**

**Dayak** – Mike "Dayak" Callaghan was born and raised in Yorkshire, UK. He joined the Royal Naval College as a cadet, and then the Green Howards (Yorkshire Regiment), followed by Officer training at Mons Cadet School. He subsequently transferred to the Gurkha Rifles.

In the mid-60s he traveled to fight in the jungles of Malaya (Borneo) during the Konfrantasi (Confrontation). It was in Malaysia that he met his first wife, a local girl. The British Army did not allow officers to marry non-whites back then so Dayak made the choice to resign from the Army to marry.

He took up work in the timber industry that led him to travel widely and live in many countries including Indonesia, Papua New Guinea, Borneo, Thailand, and Laos. He lived in the long houses of the Dayaks in Borneo for years (hence the hash name) and learned to speak their language as he did many other languages.

Dayak was active in hashing in most places he lived but particularly in Laos where he completed over 1,000 runs on both the Vientiane Hash and the Vientiane Bush Hash. He was particularly proud of reaching his thousand runs on each of those hashes without missing a single run.

He was a regular visitor to Bangkok Hash runs as far back as BH3 Run 1000 and may even have joined at that event (records are murky) but he became a full-fledged member of the BH3 in 2015. Regular visitors to Lao hash events including joint BH3-VBH3 weekends will remember him as a knowledgeable and friendly companion. Vale Dayak. On ever On.

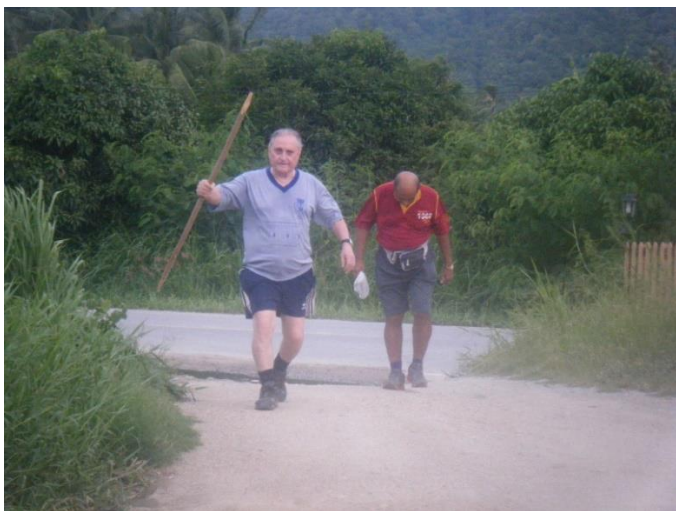

### **Colin Hastings** First run was Run #3!

The well-known British publisher and journalist Colin Hastings was killed in a car accident in Bang Saray, Chon Buri on Monday afternoon. He was 73.

The publisher of the English-language lifestyle magazine *Big Chilli*, Colin died when the car he was driving hit a wall. Emergency services were unable to revive him and he was declared dead at the scene of the accident at around 3.15pm. There were no other casualties

Colin was a long-time resident in Thailand, having arrived in the kingdom in 1973.



After gaining experience on Fleet Street, he initially worked at the *Bangkok Post* for several years and then Media Transasia before going on to develop his own publishing business which included many travel magazines.

With his outgoing personality, he became a popular figure in Bangkok's business circles.

In 1991 he became the first editor of *Thailand Tatler* magazine and in 1999 he launched *Big Chilli*, which proved very popular with expats.

Colin was an all-round sportsman and regularly played football for the Royal Bangkok Sports Club and British Club. He was also one of the top squash players in the kingdom.

### **Martin Bruessler**

Maarten 'Sir Bogdiver' Brusselers, ex-GM of BMH3 (2008/9) left for the great OnOnOn in the sky on Saturday 18th May. He was 72.

Bog joined BH3 on run 1369 on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2003 and ran with us 423 times. His last run was on 22 July 2023.

Bog was an extremely friendly Hasher, famous for being ruthlessly persistent, stubborn and never took no for an answer. He was an excellent hare, although his love of taking the pack through shiggy, water crossings and deep mud did not always go down too well with those who preferred to keep clean running shoes.

Bog moved to Phuket in the mid 80s and started Fantasea Divers, one of the first SCUBA companies on the island and pioneered liveaboard diving in Thailand. Bog was one of the original Phuket Hash members joining in 1986, as member # 6. After moving from Phuket to Bangkok in 2003 he set up a business with fellow Bangkok Hasher '4x2' manufacturing PVC windows and they sold that business in 2008. A few years ago he and his wife Tuk (T-Rex) moved to Loei province to start a hydroponic lettuce farm.

In February 2024, Maarten was diagnosed with an aggressive form of small cell lung/liver cancer and was given a few months to live. He went back to Holland to get chemo treatment to hold back the cancer, returned to Thailand and spent the last few weeks bravely visiting old friends to say goodbye. He planned to come back to Bangkok mid-May but was feeling unwell, saying that he felt the cancer had returned. He died a few days later. On Up.

His son Nick delivered a eulogy. Bog's oldest son Montri (Peter) couldn't attend, but emailed a touching letter that was read to Bog's friends. After that a few of us added our stories of the unique character we knew.

The Phinisi's owner provided beer and softies. The Harriettes, sure there wouldn't be enough food, brought baskets of food and more beer.

After about a two-hour sail we reached a point where Sir Bog's ashes, mixed with flowers, were committed to the waves. They drifted away from the boat toward Nirvana (or Holland?) in a colorful waterborne streamer.

A good man passes. Sic transit gloria Sir Bog.

## **GM's Report**

### **Grand Master's Report by Tinker**

Examining past yearbooks so I could plagiarize, the past GMs themes ran from effusive praise to vitriolic. Some annual reports have been brief. (The brevity record is 66 words!) Others long-winded, running to hundreds pages. I hope to gain the middle path with this report - a few pages of effusive vitriol.

Four of our pack graduated to the great Hash club in the sky this year. They are fondly remembered in a separate section in this yearbook.

Offices:

We had 19 offices in 23-24. A few changes are in order. When asked what did he did as Hash Liaison, the Senator said: "Nothing!" So that office is discontinued. It's been replaced by the Hash Prompter.

A new office should be considered, the "Hash Alabi". That glib individual will explain to Khun Nok why Bullit crawled in the door at 5 am covered with lipstick,

or to Pussy Virus's latest squeeze why his mug was found in Tilac's girl's hong nam full of - I leave this to your imagination.

Tradition:

Some of us are concerned that the BH3 is breaking with tradition. My take is that The BH3 is a living, breathing, evolving organism. 2566: The pre-run discussions have altered over the years from conquests last Saturday and during the week to medical conditions and the reduction in the size of your Mars bar. Many beer stops.

At one, Tinker sat in a sala with a bag full of cold beer. Front runner Porkfinder was on his 2nd bottle, we waited for the remainder to arrive and enjoyed the beauty of the location, the camaraderie and sense of achievement

2367: More mud: These are the last trail pictures as the rest of the trail was spent up to our arses in mud! . . . . the mud flat start was the only important part of the run proclaims the GM.

2377: An unhappy Thai family with three large threatening hounds refused permission to pass through their small patch of paradise.

2379: Two visitors arrived late, one a male, and other definitely not. The GM sent them both off, assuming because they were strangers and spoke no Thai, that they would become irretrievably lost in Nonthaburi. They returned! In the circle, the GM, resisting the temptation to instruct the offending pronoun to hide behind the furthest column, nominated the Senator to do what he could to assist. 24. We sing 'He's no 'fucking use' to anyone' (not 'jolly good').

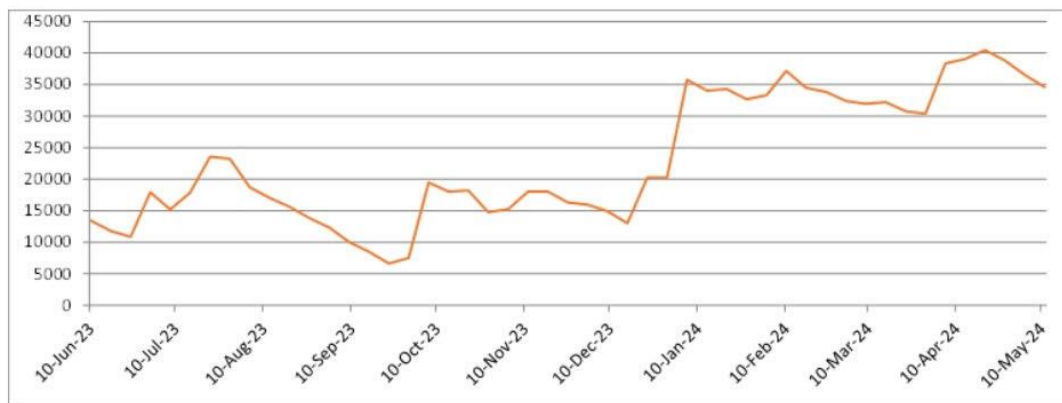
We had a smaller group of regular attendees this year, so improving attendance

Now, the other day I was down O'Sheas discussing beer, or rather the quality of Heineken, as one is want to do. There is a 335 ml insulated double glass tankard available at Macro but the best option is the Munich Beer Mug 640 ml (129 X 180 ml) available from [www.themallglass.com](http://www.themallglass.com). Let's see if the glass engraving works out...

## **BH Hash Historian Report**

Notable statistics include:

- Porkfinder reached a career 1,790 runs with an 83 % attendance. An amazing record. Close on his heels is Bullet with 1,682 runs.
- Porkfinder had a 98% run attendance this year, followed by Boob-a Lube on 92 %.
- Porkfinder co-hared five times.
- Peter Vandenhoecke hared four times and co-hared thrice. Boob-a-lube hared four times and co-hared once.
- Average run attendance increased slightly to 22 from 21 last year. The long-term average pack is about 25
- There were four New Boots.

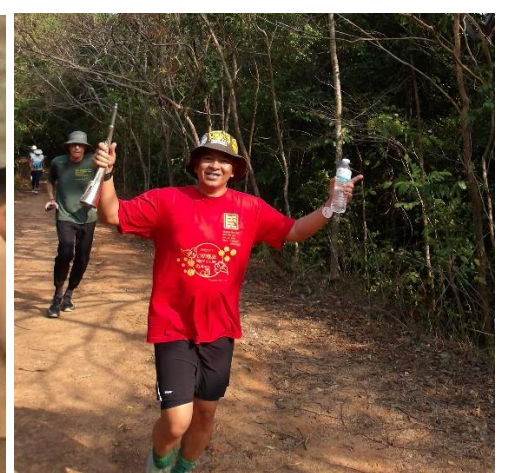

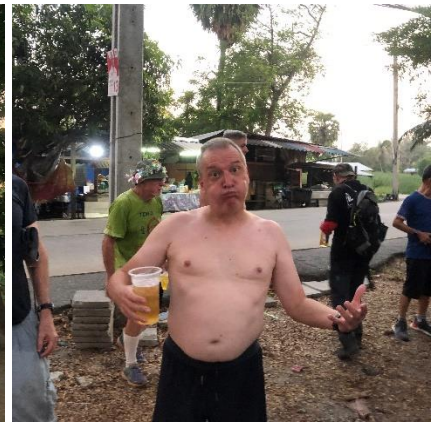

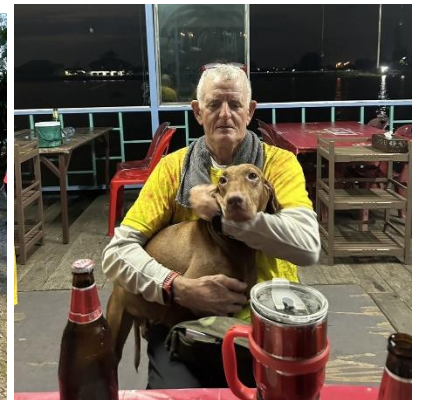
